Record Setter - The combined 105 points in the Western Washington and North Dakota game were the most ever scored in a Western football game, and also set an NCC record, breaking the mark of 102 set in South Dakota State's 60-42 victory over Mankato State in 1993. The two teams combined for 1,092 yards of offense, with UND having a 622-470 advantage.

The Notebook

AUGUSTANA - Brian Baumgartner recorded a career-high 21 tackles, including 11 solo stops, in Augustana's 36-23 loss to Nebraska-Omaha...DB Dustin Rice scored his third touchdown of the season on Saturday when he returned an interception 17 yards for a score. It was his second interception return for a TD to go with a blocked punt return for a TD. Rice now has 6 career touchdowns...After 5 games, Augustana is winning the turnover battle. The Vikings have forced 14 turnovers but have committed 11.

CENTRAL WASHINGTON - The Wildcats evened their all-time series record with Minnesota Duluth at one game apiece with their 22-point win over the Bulldogs on Saturday...QB Mike Reilly became just the fourth player in school history with more than 6,000 career passing yards as part of his 325-yard, four-touchdown performance against UMD. He also moved into third on the all-time passing list with 6,279 yards in 24 career games...WR Brandon Stout made his 2007 debut and finished with six receptions for 68 yards. Stout, who did not have a reception in his career after serving predominantly on special teams as a freshman in 2006, had been ineligible for the Wildcats' first two games...RB Johnny Lopez finished with an even 100 rushing yards, becoming the first CWU rusher to break the century mark on the ground since Lopez's 116-yard effort against Western Washington last season ... The Wildcats also had two 100-yard receivers ... Jon Rogers (CB) and Nate Pirak (LB) each had a career-high 12 tackles to share team-leading honors against UMD ... FB Durrell Moss and LB Anthony Le each made their first collegiate start for the Wildcats in last week's game...Central Washington is looking for its first-ever football victory in the state of Minnesota this week at Saint Cloud State. The Wildcats played their first-ever game in the North Star State last season at Minnesota Duluth.

MINNESOTA DULUTH - UMD welcomes Western Washington to the Malosky Stadium for the first time ever this Saturday. The Bulldogs, who are 1-3 overall for the first time since the 1999 season, will be looking to snap a three-game losing skid when it collides with the Vikings in UMD's annual Homecoming/Hall of Fame Game...Overshadowed in UMD's 43-21 setback to Central Washington this past Saturday — the first road assignment for UMD in 2007 — was another stellar performance by Ted Schlafke. The QB set a personal best for completion percentage (.775) while connecting on 30 of 41 passes for 220 yards and a pair of touchdowns. He also ran for another score. Schlafke has now passed for at least one touchdown in 25 of his 26 games as a collegian...LB Nate Fears was credited with eight total tackles last Saturday in Ellensburg, Wash. to eclipse the 200-tackle mark for his career (only the 12th Bulldog to ever to so)...WR Dennis Carter was on the receiving end of both of Schlafke's scoring strikes at Central Washington which boosted his NCC-high touchdown reception total to eight. He and WR Tony Doherty pace the Bulldogs with 20 catches each through four games...Rob Casasnovas, who was bothered by an ailing shoulder earlier this season, made his collegiate debut against Central Washington and ran twice for 10 yards while becoming the fifth UMD true freshman to be called into action already in 2007...UMD tops the NCC in red zone offense efficiency, having come away with points in 12 of its 13 visits there this season (92.3 percent)...Luke Radke is saving some of his best punting for last as he has averaged an NCC-best 42.4 yards per kick thus far.

MINNESOTA STATE - Minnesota State has won at least three of its first four games 25 times in school history. Prior to this season, the last time the squad accomplished the feat was in 1997, the final year a three-year span in which the school opened its season 3-1. This is the fifth time in school history that the school has started 3-1, with its lone loss coming in the second game...Of the 25 times MSU has started 3-1 in school history, just three times has the school not ended the season with a winning record. Those three seasons were 1995, 1996 and 1997, the last three times that the Mavericks has accomplished the feat...MSU is 0-1 coming out of the bye week under Jeff Jamrog, with its lone loss coming to Nebraska-Omaha last year

NEBRASKA-OMAHA - SS Randy Kush became the all-time leader in interceptions when he picked off his 16th in the final quarter at Augustana Sept. 22. Gary Paporello (1966-69) had the record for almost 40 years until Kush tied it vs. Northwest Missouri State Sept. 8. The Gretna High School grad is a two-time all-NCC second-team selection. He was second in NCAA Division II as a sophomore in 2005 with nine interceptions. ... Zach Miller, who last season became just the third UNO QB to rush for more than 1,000 yards, recorded career-best passing games in in each of the first three games.

Miller, a 6-4, 222-pound junior from Weston, Neb., passed for 195, 246 and 283 yards in the three games. He set a school record with an .889 completion percentage (16-for-18) in the 45-10 win over Western Washington. The old mark of .857 (12-14) was set by Brian Masek in 2004.

NORTH DAKOTA - UND hosts Augustana Saturday in the annual Homecoming game at the Alerus Center...The Sioux are coming off of a 63-42 win at Western Washington on Saturday, the highest scoring NCC game in league history...UND racked up 500-plus yards for a school-record fourth straight game, finishing 20 yards shy of the school record with 622...QB Danny Freund went 17-for-22 for 319 yards and tossed five TDs for the second time this season...Freund led the Sioux to touchdowns on their first three possessions in each half...RB Ryan Chappell carried 24 times for 214 yards and four touchdowns, including a 90-yard scoring run. Chappell has now run 42 times for 520 yards and six TDs in his last two games alone...WR Weston Dressler caught seven passes for 165 yards and two TDs, all in the first half, and is now 61 yards from breaking Phillip Moore's school record for career all-purpose yards...UND's 63 points were its most in a conference game since 1972...It was also the most points allowed by Western Washington since 1978...The Sioux enter Saturday's game having won 31 of their last 32 games at the Alerus Center.

ST. CLOUD STATE - WR Zach Stover caught a career-high nine passes against USD and finished the day with 70 receiving yards...QB Jake Kranz made his collegiate debut in the fourth quarter on Saturday and completed his first play from scrimmage, a seven yard pass to WR Cody Rysewyk...The Huskies extended their consecutive games streak with a QB sack to 36 as SCSU tallied three QB sacks on the day...DT Chuck Merritt notched two QB sacks, the first of his collegiate career and finished the game with five tackles, one forced fumble and 3.5 tackles for loss... The Huskies are 5-4 in NCC openers under head coach Randy Hedberg...The shutout was the first suffered by the Huskies since the 2001 season against UNO...The Husky defense has only allowed six third quarter points this season (two field goals)

SOUTH DAKOTA - With their 31-0 win over St. Cloud State on Saturday, USD extended its home winning streak to 21 straight games. Head coach Ed Meierkort is a perfect 20-0 in his career at the DakotaDome...The Coyotes recorded their first shutout since August 31, 2006 against Quincy. USD defeated Quincy 59-0 in the 2006 season opener...The Coyote defense limited St. Cloud State to 41 yards rushing in the game and also limited them to convert only 5-of-17 third down plays. USD QB Noah Shepard completed 12-of-16 passes for 259 yards and three touchdowns. He now has a quarterback rating of 176.7 on the season with 1,268 yards and 14 touchdown passes...WR Jordan Murphy had his best game of the season with six catches for 166 yards and two touchdowns...Frank Leibfarth's career-best 52-yard field goal was two yards shy of tying the school record of 54 which was set by Mike Kneip who set the record in 1989 against Nebraska-Omaha.

WESTERN WASHINGTON - Coming off perhaps the toughest opening three games of any NCAA Division II team in the country, Western Washington (1-2 overall, 0-2 NCC) is at Minnesota Duluth Saturday...Last week in their home opener, the Vikings lost 63-42 to North Dakota in the highest-scoring game in school and NCC history...The previous week, Western was beaten 45-10 at Nebraska-Omaha. The loss snapped a four-game winning streak for the Vikings, who, had opened the season with a 28-21 victory at NCAA I-FCS UC Davis...The Vikings have given up 108 points in their last two games, and on the season are allowing averages of 43.0 points, 522.7 total yards and 6.1 yards per rushing carry...In a 63-42 loss last week to North Dakota, they gave up 622 yards and 63 points...The defensive unit, which has had five starters go down with injuries, is led by MLB Shane Simmons, who has a NCC-leading 33 tackles and 2.5 tackles for losses of minus-10 yards. Simmons has had double-figure tackles in seven of the eight games he has played for Western since transferring from Idaho...RB Craig Garner ran for a career-high 192 yards against North Dakota, tying a school record with four touchdowns, after racking up 140 yards the previous week at Nebraska-Omaha. That gave him six 100-yard rushing efforts in Western's last seven games. Garner is averaging 119.3 yards per game on the ground this season (358 total), fourth in the NCC, with five touchdowns, and is averaging 19.3 yards on 10 kickoff returns...QB Adam Perry, who has completed 60.4 percent of his passes (61-of-101) for 742 yards and four touchdowns with two interceptions. Perry's top receivers are Rick Copsey, 13 catches for 167 yards and one touchdown; Casey Dell, 13 catches for 140 yards; and Travis McKee, 12 catches for 101 yards and one touchdown. Rocki Sandusky is averaging 40.8 yards on four catches, one for a touchdown. Dell is averaging 10.8 yards in six punt returns...Western leads the NCC in red zone efficiency at 84.6 percent with seven touchdowns and four field goals...The Vikings have added transfer RB Randall Eldridge to their roster. He was a standout player at Chabot Junior College in Hayward, Calif.
