## Offensive Player of the Week

**Brian McNeill**  
**Nebraska-Omaha**

Brian McNeill of Nebraska-Omaha has been named the NCC Offensive Player of the Week.

McNeill, a junior running back from Philadelphia, Pa., rushed 28 times for 237 yards (8.5 ypc) and three touchdowns as Nebraska-Omaha downed North Dakota 28-17 in a battle of the league's two unbeaten teams. The 237-yard effort was the fifth best rushing performance in UNO history.

Grant Smith of Minnesota State and Dustin Rice of Augustana have been named the NCC Defensive Players of the Week.

Smith, a senior defensive end from Farmington, Minn., tallied a school-record 4 1/2 sacks for a loss of 35 yards as Minnesota State downed Minnesota Duluth. Smith finished the day with nine tackles (7 solo, 2 assist) along with another tackle for loss on top of his sacks. As a team MSU tied a school record with seven sacks in the game.

Rice, a senior defensive back from Lead, S.D., returned an interception for 36 yards and a touchdown and blocked a punt in Augie's win at St. Cloud State. For the day he also had seven tackles (5 solo, 2 assists) and a pass breakup.

**UND Tops Regional Rankings** - The NCAA published region rankings for first time this season and Nebraska-Omaha holds the top spot with North Dakota in second and Central Washington in fourth. South Dakota holds the sixth place with Minnesota State in the 9th spot and Minnesota Duluth in 12th. Six of the league's 10 teams are ranked in the region top-12. The NCC holds the top spot in each of the fall sports (football, volleyball and soccer) in the first week of the rankings.

**Road Warriors** - Only South Dakota was able to win a game at home Saturday. All other four games that involved NCC teams were won by the visiting team. The biggest game in terms of conference and regional implications was Nebraska-Omaha knocking off North Dakota in Grand Forks. But the Mavericks have had success in Grand Forks. Of the six home losses that UND has sustained since moving to the Alerus Center, three have come against Nebraska-Omaha.

### The Notebook

**AUGUSTANA** - Augustana's defense and special teams made several big plays in Saturday's 44-18 win over St. Cloud State. The Viking defense scored 3 touchdowns, all in the second half - a 36-yard interception return by Dustin Rice, a 44-yard interception return by Brian Baumgartner and a 59-yard fumble return by Chris Janisch. The special teams unit successfully executed an onside kick and forced turnovers on a kickoff return and a punt return...Dustin Rice's 36-yard interception return for a touchdown was his third pick for a score this season and the sixth of his career. He also has a blocked punt return for a touchdown this season, giving him seven career touchdowns. That is the third-highest career total among active players, trailing only Tommy Ellingworth (16) and Jordan Nordquist (8).

**CENTRAL WASHINGTON** - The Wildcats won their eighth consecutive head-to-head meeting with Western Oregon last weekend, defeating their former conference rivals by a commanding 49-14 margin...Central had five interceptions in the game - its highest single-game total since picking off five against WOU in 2005...SS Jerome Williams had two of those picks, marking the first two interceptions of his career, while LB Chase Hessler also picked off his first career pass in the fourth quarter to go along with his first collegiate tackles...QB Mike Reilly surpassed the 7,000-yard passing plateau in his 27th career game, matching the quickest to 7,000 yards in CWU history. Current Detroit Lion Jon Kitna, who is the school's all-time passing leader with 12,353 career yards, also accomplished the feat in 27 career games...WR Johnny Spevak had another 100-yard receiving game - his second straight overall and third this season. Spevak also had three touchdown catches, matching a career-high total he had established against Western Oregon last season...RB Micah Lape scored his first career touchdown in the fourth quarter on an 11-yard carry... Central Washington will put its four-game win streak - the program's longest since winning seven straight to conclude the 2005 season - on the line this Saturday at the fifth annual Wells Fargo Battle in Seattle, presented by Comcast, against Western Washington. The Wildcats have won three of the previous four Battles, and lead the all-time series with their archrivals by a 60-33-4 count.

**MINNESOTA DULUTH** - UMD returns to road action this Saturday when it will pay just its second visit ever to Nebraska-Omaha's Al F. Caniglia Field...The Bulldogs had their season-high two-game winning streak snapped Saturday via a 35-14 loss to visiting Minnesota State. UMD had held a 14-7 lead three minutes into the second quarter before surrendering 28 unanswered points, including 21 in the second half. The two teams combined for 121 pass attempts (just 10 shy of the all-time NCAA II record) and 69 completions...QB Ted Schlafke, who tops the NCC in pass completions (204) and is second in total offense (314.0 yards per game) has now thrown at least one touchdown pass in 28 of his 29 games as a Bulldog...FS Jim Johnson had a pair of interceptions (both of which led to Bulldog touchdowns) in Saturday's loss to take over the 2007 Bulldog lead in that department with four. Those four thefts also tie him for the the top spot on the current NCC charts as well...Some 14 different Bulldogs have registered a pass reception this fall, including sophomore wide out Luke Schalekamp, who made his first collegiate touchdown catch Saturday.

**MINNESOTA STATE** - Ben King and Hansen connected for a touchdown pass for the five times this season...King and Donte Shackelford have connected on touchdown passes six times this season...King has gone over the 20+ completion mark 18 times in his career and three times this season...King has thrown for over 250 yards 19 times in his career and five times this year...King has thrown three or more touchdown passes in four games this year...King has thrown for over 300 yards in the win, it marked the eighth time in his career he has done so and the fifth of the season...He has thrown for at least 300 yards in his last three games...King surpassed John Hebgen (1993-96) as the school's all-time leader in passing yards...King now has 9,455 career passing yards...King also hold the school record for pass completions and pass attempts.

**NEBRASKA-OMAHA** - The magic number is 38 when UNO and Minnesota Duluth face each other in football. The teams have met just three times previously, but each time the winning score has been 38. UNO won last year, 38-14 in Duluth. The teams have met just once before in Omaha, in the initial game of the series in 2004. UNO won that game, 38-24... Brian McNeill posted his second-straight 200-yard game in the win over North Dakota, rolling up 237 yards, while scoring three times. It was the fifth-best rushing performance in school history. McNeill ran for 209 yards in the Sept. 29 win over Minnesota State. McNeill became the 14th Maverick to rush for more than 1,000 yards in a season. His final run, a 39-yard touchdown, vs. North Dakota, pushed him to 1,010 for the season. He trails No. 13 Charlie McWhorter (1971) by eight yards. The leader is Justin Kammrad, who led NCAA II with 1,866 yards in 2003.

**NORTH DAKOTA** - UND is idle this week after suffering its first loss of the season on Saturday, a 28-17 home loss to Nebraska-Omaha...The Sioux amassed 492 yards of total offense, breaking a string of six consecutive games with at least 500 yards...The loss snapped UND's 10-game home winning streak and it was just UND's second loss in the last 34 home games. Both of those losses have come at the hands of UNO...WR Weston Dressler caught 11 passes for a career-high 192 yards and a touchdown. His 192 yards rank as the fifth-best single-game receiving performance in school history... Fellow WR Brady Trenbeath matched his career high with 10 catches. He racked up 115 yards and a touchdown...QB Danny Freund was 27-for-45 for a career-high 366 yards and two touchdowns...The Sioux return to action next Saturday when they take to the road to face Minnesota Duluth.

**ST. CLOUD STATE** - The Huskies are looking to break a four-game NCC losing streak at Minnesota State Saturday and retain the coveted Traveling Training Kit...SCSU has won four straight games against the Mavericks and leads the all-time series 37-30...WR Fred Williams caught five passes for a season- and career-high 142 yards and two touchdowns Saturday against Augustana...Williams scored 70 and 35 yard pass plays, with the 70-yard effort the longest scoring play of the season for the Huskies...The SCSU defense intercepted four Augie passes...DE Ryan Kees, DB Philip Hedlof, DB's Bryce Kieffer, and Matt Jensen, all had picks...Kees returned his first collegiate pick 33 yards...Jensen leads the Huskies with three INT's this season...SCSU also recorded four QB sacks led by DE Cale Pulczynski with 1.5 and he leads the Huskies with 5.0 QB sacks this season.

**SOUTH DAKOTA** - USD extended its home winning streak to 22 consecutive games in the 24-10 win over Western Washington...The win also extended South Dakota's homecoming winning streak to seven. With their 24-10 win over Western Washington, the Coyotes have now outscored their opponents 169-60 during the seven-game winning streak on Dakota Days...Brooks Little broke the USD career receptions record in story book fashion. With no score in the first quarter and the Coyotes facing a second and long, Little hauled in a deep pass from Noah Shepard and ran it in 51 yards for a touchdown...Amos Allen also had an impressive note in the game. He ran the ball 25 times for 136 yards and one touchdown...The USD defense was led by John Morales, who had a career day. The defensive end had a career-high three sacks as USD as a team combined for seven...They limited Western Washington to just 199 yards of total offense, the lowest amount of yardage by an opponent this season. They allowed just 105 yards passing, also the lowest amount this season, and held an opponent to under 200 yards passing for the third time this season.

**WESTERN WASHINGTON** - With state bragging rights on the line, Western Washington meets nationally ranked Central Washington in the fifth annual Battle in Seattle for the Cascade Cup on Saturday (6 p.m.) at Qwest Field in Seattle, Wash. The first BIS in 2003 was played before 16,392 fans, a record for a non-NCAA Division I collegiate football game in the state of Washington with Central prevailing 29-20. Western won the 2004 meeting, 28-21, with 11,458 in attendance, but the Wildcats bounced back for a 37-17 victory in 2005 with a crowd of 11,312, and won again 42-28 in 2006 before 11,153 fans ...The lead has changed hands at least once in all four of the previous Battle in Seattle contests...Western has forced four turnovers in each of its last two games, holding South Dakota nearly 11 points and 175 total yards below its season averages...Leading Western's defense is MLB Shane Simmons, a 2007 second-team D2football.com pre-season All-American. Simmons tops the NCC in tackles with 78 (13.0 avg.), including five for loss...RB Craig Garner, who missed the St. Cloud State game with a bruised knee, returned to action with 118 yards rushing versus South Dakota. He has run for 100 or more yards in seven of his last nine games...K Josh Lider has made a NCC-best 9-of-11 field-goal attempts (81.8 percent), making his first eight to tie a school-record also held by current Atlanta Falcons punter Michael Koenen. Western leads the NCC in time of possession (32:27) and net punting average (34.2).
