**Augustana** - Marques Blank and Nick Olson both shot the ball well last week. Blank shot 69.2 percent (9-for-13) from the field and 62.5 percent (5-for-8) from the 3-point line, while Olson shot 66.7 percent (12-for-18) from the field and 75.0 percent (9-for-12) from the 3-point line...Augustana outrebounded its opponents 72-57 last week.

**Minnesota Duluth -** UMD is off to its first 3-0 start since the 1996-97 season and first under head coach Gary Holquist. The Bulldogs are averaging four players in double figure scoring through the three contests.

**Minnesota State -** G Luke Anderson has 1,739 career points, and trails Brian Koepnick (1,759) by 20 points to become the school's all-time leading scorer. Anderson, could become the school's all-time leading scorer Tuesday, when the Mavericks travel to Concordia-St. Paul. Over his career, Anderson has scored 20 or more points twice against Concordia-St.Paul, including a 26-point effort in MSU's 95-78 home victory....MSU has out rebounded its opponents 93-52 this season. In its opening game victory over Felician, MSU owned a 52-30 (+22) advantage on the glass, which was the largest rebounding margin since posting a 35-rebound difference against Crossroads, Nov. 23, 2004. MSU has scored 38 points off rebounds this season, and owns a +11 margin on the offensive glass for the season...Minnesota State has turned 34 opponent turnovers into 49 points so far this season. The Mavericks forced a 18 turnovers against Dominican....Minnesota State through two games this season, MSU has scored 82 of its 177 points (46%) in the paint.
