Offensive Players of the Week Andrea Oswald Augustana Rachel Langseth Minnesota Duluth

Andrea Oswald of Augustana and Rachel Langseth of Minnesota Duluth have been named the Offensive Players of the Week by the North Central Conference.

Oswald, a senior middle blocker from Pilger, Neb., averaged 5.08 kills while hitting .278 (66k-21e-162ta) in three wins at the Washburn Lady Blues Classic.

Langseth, a senior middle blocker from Alexandria, Minn., hit .372 (71k-17e-145ta) while averaging 4.18 kills per game in five matches last week, including three matches against top 25 teams.

Setter of the Week Katie Gangelhoff Minnesota Duluth

Katie Gangelhoff of Minnesota Duluth has been named the Setter of the Week by the North Central Conference.

Gangelhoff, a sophomore from South St. Paul, Minn., averaged 15.00 assists per game as the Bulldogs went 4-1 last week, including three matches against top 25 teams. She also hit .371 (15k-2e-35a) while averaging 0.88 kills per game.

NCC Season Next - The NCC season is slated to open on Friday with three matches and continue with two matches on Saturday. All seven teams will see NCC action this week. NCC play will continue mostly on weekends through November 4. The NCC schedule is double round-robin with each school playing the six others once at home and once on the road.

Not In Kansas Anymore - Five of the seven NCC schools participated in the Washburn Lady Blues Invitational over the weekend. The tournament featured mostly teams from the Mid-American Athletics Association along with North Alabama. NCC teams posted a 12-7 mark at the tournament. Several NCC players were named to the All-Tournament teams and their names can be found in The Notebook below.

The Notebook

AUGUSTANA - Andrea Oswald was named to the Washburn Invitational All-Tournament Team, her third all-tournament team selection this season ... By recording 22 kills in all 3 matches last week, Oswald now has 7 20-plus kill matches this season.

MINNESOTA DULUTH - University of Minnesota Duluth volleyball team went 3-1 at the Washburn Lady Blues Classic this past weekend. The Bulldogs defeated University of North Alabama, Emporia State University and Northwest Missouri State University before falling to Truman State University in UMD's final game of the tournament...Junior Rachel Langseth, junior Kari Wolford and junior Vicky Braegelman were all named to the Washburn Lady Blues Classic All-Tournament team.

MINNESOTA STATE - Minnesota State has recorded six shutouts this season - all 3-0 wins - twice sweeping Fort Hays State...Through 12 matches this season, Lady Blues Classic All-Tournament selection Cassie Wolpern has led the Mavericks in kills three times, in digs four times, and has also tied for team-high in digs in one match, and tied for team-high in both kills and digs in one match.

NEBRASKA-OMAHA - UNO is 1-2 against top-10 opponents this season. The Mavs upset 10th-ranked Central Missouri State in five games in the season-opener. UNO lost 3-0 to No. 4 Truman State and 3-1 to No. 9 Washburn at the Washburn Lady Blues Classic...Nebraska-Omaha is currently ranked No. 12 in the nation, which is the highest ranking for UNO since the 2000 season...When the Mavericks play fifth—ranked Minnesota Duluth on Friday night, it will be the third time UNO has met a top-10 opponent in the last four matches.

ST. CLOUD STATE - Junior right side hitter Kristi Pangrac currently leads the Huskies with a .291 hitting percentage and is second on the team with 121 kills in 39 games played...Senior co-captain Lindsey Gothe needs just 33 digs to break into the top ten list in the history of SCSU's volleyball program. Currently, Gothe has 812 digs and is 13th on the all-time digs list at SCSU.

SOUTH DAKOTA - USD had a season-high four players reach double-digits in kills against Pittsburg State (9/9)...The Coyotes still have five matches remaining on their season-opening 17-match road trip... Head coach Brian Lamppa earned his 50th-victory as head coach of the Coyotes when South Dakota defeated Fort Hays State last Friday.
