Three Weeks - Only three weeks remain in the 2006 NCC season. That means four matches for Minnesota Duluth, Minnesota State, Nebraska-Omaha and South Dakota and five matches for Augustana and North Dakota. St. Cloud State has six matches remaining.

The Notebook

AUGUSTANA - Since September 8, Augustana has a 9-5 record. All 5 of those losses have come against nationally ranked opponents...The Vikings hit a season-high .393 in Friday's 3-0 sweep of St. Cloud State. Augustana had 53 kills with only 9 errors on 112 attempts. Two Vikings hit over .500 in the match. Andrea Oswald hit .571 (13 kills, 1 errors, 21 attempts, while Terrin Post hit .538 (15 kills, 1 errors, 26 attempts)...The Vikings play their final 2 home matches of the season this weekend. They host North Dakota on Friday and Minnesota State on Saturday.

MINNESOTA DULUTH - Two-time AVCA All-American junior outside hitter Vicky Braegelmann racked up 40 kills in the two matches and sophomore setter Katie Gangelhoff dished out 105 assists.

MINNESOTA STATE - Senior outside hitter Cassie Wolpern recorded her ninth double-double of the season with 14 kills and 19 digs - both team highs - in Saturday's win over St. Cloud State University. She has now tallied double figure kill totals in 13 matches this season...Saturday's match drew 505 fans to Taylor Center, the second highest tally of the season. 544 fans came to see Minnesota State take on Minnesota Duluth on Sept. 30...Stef Sandstrom nearly matched a season-high with 18 digs Saturday. She posted 20 digs against Nova Southeastern on August 26...Junior middle hitter Megan Stroud posted 7 blocks on Saturday as the Mavericks totaled 15.

NEBRASKA-OMAHA - UNO is 1-4 against top-10 opponents this season. The Mavs upset 10th-ranked Central Missouri State in five games in the season-opener. UNO lost 3-0 to No. 1 Truman State and 3-1 to No. 9 Washburn at the Washburn Lady Blues Classic. The Mavs have lost a pair of matches to fifth-ranked Minnesota Duluth...UNO's home-opener against Nebraska-Kearney drew 1,527 fans to the Sapp Fieldhouse, the largest in Division II this season...Nebraska-Omaha is currently ranked No. 20 in the nation...Christina Reicks has recorded nine-straight double-doubles and leads the 2006 Mavericks with 16 on the year. Reicks was named the NCC Defensive Player of the Week on Aug. 28 and Oct. 9...Carlie Christensen has hit .400 or better in 10 matches this season. She has hit .500 or better in seven matches...Katie Agnew currently ranks 13th on the UNO career records chart with 972 assists...Carlie Christensen ranks 11th on the UNO career records chart with 272 block assists...Stacie Wemhoff sits at 20th in career digs with 935.

NORTH DAKOTA - The Sioux took down Minnesota State in three games. Leading the way for the Sioux this past week was junior Tara Holmen. Holmen had a season-high 20 kills against Minnesota-Crookston and against Minnesota State she had nine kills. For the week Holmen averaged 4.83 kills per game. Allison Louwagie had another excellent week as she finished the UMC game with 40 set assists and 11 digs and then against Minnesota State had 42 set assists. For the week Louwagie averaged 13.67 assists per game.

ST. CLOUD STATE - Sophomore libero Andreana Pieper tallied a season-high 28 digs against Minnesota State on Oct. 14, in the Taylor Center...Junior right side hitter Kristi Pangrac now ranks 13th on the all-time kills per game list at SCSU with 2.72 kpg in 256 games played...Lindsey Gothe is closing in on 1,000 career digs at SCSU. Gothe continues to rank fifth on the all-time digs list at SCSU with 964 career digs in a Husky uniform.

SOUTH DAKOTA - Though the Coyotes dropped both matches, they forced #20 Nebraska-Omaha to four games before extending #5 Minnesota Duluth to five...USD is only the third school to force the Bulldogs to a fifth game this season and ended their consecutive games-won streak at 16...South Dakota will hit the road for the final time this season with games this weekend at Minnesota State and St. Cloud State before returning home for four matches to conclude the year.
