Offensive Players of the Week Carlie Christensen Nebraska-Omaha Vicky Braegelmann Minnesota Duluth

Carlie Christensen of Nebraska-Omaha and Vicky Braegelmann of Minnesota Duluth have been named the Offensive Players of the Week by the North Central Conference.

Christensen, a junior middle blocker from Omaha, Neb., hit .484 (18k-3e-31ta) while averaging 4.50 kills per game in UNO's win over North Dakota.

Braegelmann, a junior outside hitter from Albany, Minn., hit .400 (31k-11e-50ta) in wins over Michigan Tech and St. Cloud State. She averaged 5.17 kills per game

Countdown - The countdown is now on to the end of the NCC season with only two weeks remaining. After winning its only NCC match of the week, Minnesota Duluth now only needs one win or one Augustana loss to assure the Bulldogs of at least a share of the NCC title. And as the schedule has it, that will be decided on the court when Augustana travels northeast to play Minnesota Duluth Saturday afternoon. Augustana would be assured of at least second place with either a win or a loss by North Dakota, Nebraska-Omaha or Minnesota State. Those three teams are in the closest competition for placing with UND and UNO at 5-4 while Minnesota State is 5-5. Of those teams, MSU plays at North Dakota Friday.

The Notebook

AUGUSTANA - With a weekend sweep against North Dakota and Minnesota State, Augustana improved to 12-6 since starting the season 1-5...The Vikings went 3-1 on its recent 2-week homestand to finish the year with a 5-3 home record...Ellen Andrews matched a career high with 15 kills and Lisa Hoegh matched a career high with 51 assists as the Vikings upended North Dakota...The Vikings' 3 seniors had big nights in their final home match against Minnesota State. Terrin Post had 17 kills, Andrea Oswald had 13 kills and 2 blocks and Abby Schmidt had 24 digs in the win over MSU.

MINNESOTA DULUTH - Outside hitter Vicky Braegelmann pounded down 31 kills combined in the two matches in wins over Michigan Tech and St. Cloud State last week...Setter Katie Gangelhoff dished out 86 assists and libero Chelsea Meierotto had 29 digs in the two matches.

MINNESOTA STATE - Setter Stef Sandstrom has established a new career-best for assists in a season. She posted 120 assists in three matches last week to boost her season-total to 1018, eclipsing her previous best of 973 assists which led the Mavericks last season...Outside hitter Cassie Wolpern had 18 kills and 23 digs to lead the Mavericks to a 3-2 win over South Dakota Friday night. Wolpern followed with 11 kills and 17 digs against Augustana on Saturday, bringing her double-double season total to 11...Middle hitter Megan Stroud and senior outside hitter Mandy Reuter each tallied five blocks against South Dakota on Friday. Stroud currently leads the team with 60 blocks.

NEBRASKA-OMAHA - Christina Reicks has recorded 10-straight doublle-doubles and leads the Mavericks with 17 on the year. Reicks was named the NCC Defensive Player of the Week on Aug. 28 and Oct. 9....Carlie Christensen has hit ..400 or better in 11 matches this season. She has hit .500 or better in seven matches...Katie Agnew currenntly ranks 13th on the UNO career records chart with 1,023 assists...Carlie Christensen ranks 11th on the UUNO career records chart with 285 block assists...Stacie Wemhoff sits at 20th in career digs with 969.

NORTH DAKOTA - The Sioux have one more road trip left as they travel to Moorhead, Minn. to take on Minnesota State-Moorhead in a non-conference battle on Tuesday...After the trip, the Sioux have three straight home games against conference opponents; Minnesota State, St. Cloud State and Minnesota Duluth...The games this past weekends brought about some outstanding career milestones...Aileen Cahill went into the weekend needing 26 digs to reach the 1,000 dig milestone, and came away with 27 digs to surpass the coveted mark. Next in Cahill's sites are the 1,000 kills mark, as she currently sits only 13 kills away...For the week, the Sioux had some outstanding individual performances. Against Augustana, Heidi Evans completed her ninth double-double of the season with 19 kills and 27 digs....Setter Allison Louwagie had two outstanding games with 56 set assists against Augustana and against Nebraska Omaha she has 41 set assists and 16 digs which was her seventh double-double of the season

ST. CLOUD STATE - SCSU tallied its first NCC win of the season against South Dakota on Saturday, Oct. 21...Lindsey Gothe has now charted 1,000 digs in a Husky uniform and continues to stay in 5th place on the all-time career digs list at SCSU...Right side hitter Kristi Pangrac currently ranks 6th in the NCC with a .310 hitting percentage and a 3.65 kills per game average. Pangrac leads the Huskies in 2006 with 354 kills and ranks 12th on the all-time kills per game list at SCSU with 2.79 kpg (270 career games).
