The Notebook

AUGUSTANA - Augustana is now 12-3 on the season with all 3 losses coming to ranked opponents. . .When Augie wins 1 game in a match they are 12-0. All 3 of their losses have been 3-0 decisions. . .Rebecca Hindman had a happy 21st birthday against South Dakota. She entered the match midway through the second game and proceeded to collect a career-high 11 kills in helping the Vikings upend the Coyotes. In that match, Ellen Andrews and Cayla Schroeder set career highs in kills (23 apiece), Jenna Lago had a career-high 31 digs and Lisa Hoegh set career highs in assists (69) and digs (24).

MINNESOTA DULUTH - In a match featuring one of the most intense rivalries in NCAA Division II volleyball, No. 4 Minnesota Duluth defeated No. 3 Concordia-St. Paul in five games (20-30, 37-35, 30-20, 32-20, 15-12) last Tuesday. The Bulldogs were facing Concordia-St. Paul for the first time since defeating the Golden Bears on Nov. 11, 2006 to advance to the NCAA Elite Eight. The match also represented the first time since Nov. 9, 2004 that the two squads played to five-games in a contest...The Bulldogs opened NCC play this past weekend with wins over Nebraska-Omaha and North Dakota. With the win over North Dakota on Saturday, UMD is now 14-1 on the season and winners of 12 straight matches...The Bulldogs have won 20 league matches in a row, last losing in conference play back on Oct. 21, 2005 against the Nebraska-Omaha. UMD has now won 25-straight home matches, last losing at Romano Gymnasium on Aug. 26, 2005 against Cal State-San Bernardino.

MINNESOTA STATE - The Mavericks defeated North Dakota in a three-game match by the scores of 30-20, 31-29 and 30-21. S Stef Sandstrom led the team in assists with 32. MH Megan Stroud led the team in kills with 13. Ashley Nachreiner led the team in digs with 12...The Mavericks defeated Nebraska-Omaha in a three-game match by the scores of 30-28, 30-22 and 32-30. S Stef Sandstrom tallied 41 assists and 10 digs. OH Amanda Beekman led the team in kills with 20. OH Dana Ostertag led the team with 17 digs.

NEBRASKA-OMAHA - All-American Carlie Christensen will be looking to become the 16th player in school history to record 1,000 career kills. The senior from Omaha has tallied 998 kills to date...MB Carlie Christensen has moved up to sixth on the Maverick career charts with 345 block assists...S Katie Agnew ranks 10th with 1,708 career set assists.

NORTH DAKOTA - UND went 0-2 in its opening weekend of NCC play losing to #23 Minnesota State and #4 Minnesota Duluth...UND is now 0-5 this season against ranked opponent. . .Amanda Polzin led the Sioux offensively this weekend as Polzin finished with 11 kills against Minnesota State and 12 kills against Minnesota Duluth...UND will have a non-conference bout against Minnesota-Crookston on Tuesday...UND has already beaten UMC once this season.

ST. CLOUD STATE - The Huskies are 5-8 overall and 0-1 in the NCC in 2007. SCSU prepares for Winona State on Tuesday, Sept. 18, in Halenbeck Hall...SCSU's Andreaana Pieper is closing in on 1,000 career digs. The junior libero as totaled 921 career digs in 256 games played (3.60 dpg).
