Erika Quigley
 St. Cloud State

Amy Puthoff
 Augustana

Erika Quigley of St. Cloud State and Amy Puthoff of Augustana have been named the NCC Players of the Week for the second consecutive week.

Quigley, a senior post from Duluth, Minn., averaged 32.5 points, 15.3 rebounds, 1.5 assists, and 2.5 blocked shots per game in key wins over regional foes Concordia-St. Paul and Minnesota State Moorhead.

She shot .510 (25-49) from the field and .714 (15x21) from the free throw line. Her 38-point performance against Minnesota State Moorhead tied the SCSU record for points in a game.

Puthoff, a sophomore guard from Hartford, S.D., came off the bench to shoot .594 (19x32) from the field and .524 (11x21) from three-point range in three dominating Augie wins. She also hit all 11 of her free throw attempts.

Puthoff averaged 20.0 points, 4.0 rebounds, 2.3 assists and 2.0 steals per game.

The Notebook

Augustana - Augustana extended its winning streak to 12 games with 3 wins last week. The 12-game winning streak is the team's longest winning streak since the 2002-03 season when the Vikings won 13 straight games...Against Mount Mercy, Augustana tied a school record with 15 blocked shots. Ashley Holiday, the school's all-blocked shots leader, and Whitney Hofer each had 4 rejections. In all, 6 different players had a blocked shot...Augustana has now held 8 opponents to 50 points or less. Bethany Lutheran avoided being in that group when they scored 51 points...Augustana's 121 points scored against Bethany Lutheran ties the third-highest single-game point total in school history ...Amy Puthoff led the charge against Bethany Lutheran by scoring a career-high 28 points...Puthoff was a perfect 11-for-11 from the free throw line last week.

Minnesota Duluth - UMD is rolling on an eight game unbeaten steak after trouncing both St. Scholastica and Minnesota Crookston last week...The Bulldogs, who are a perfect 30-0 against the Saints all-time, were led in scoring both games by Katie Winkelman... Winkelman tallied 16 points against CSS and 13 against the Golden Eagles, along with 10 boards for her second double-double of the season.

St. Cloud State - SCSU went 2-0 on the road after their four-game homestand two weeks ago...They began the week with Head Coach Dr. Lori Ulferts 200th win of her career at SCSU, over Concordia-St. Paul, 77-71...The tightly contested game was defined when Erika Quigley blocked a shot at the three-point line in CSP's attempt to come back within one late in the game, she scored two on the fast-break securing the win for the Huskies...Quigley led the Huskies, scoring 27 points and charting 17 boards. In their first overtime appearance of the season, the Huskies took a demanding lead in the second overtime against MSU-Moorhead to force the Dragons into foul trouble and win their tenth game of the season...The Huskies overcame a seven-point deficit after the first half that was aided by Kayla Rengel, who scored 17 of her 19 points after intermission...Quigley charted 38 points against the Dragons, tying the school record for most points scored by an individual in a single game. The Huskies have won six in a row, and have a 3-1 record against NSIC teams.

South Dakota - The South Dakota women's team has opened 8-1, which is its best start since the 2003-04 team started 15-1...USD is averaging 76.7 points per game while giving up 59.9 points a contest...The Coyotes are hitting on 41.3 percent (231-559) from the field, including 38.2 percent from three-point range (84-223). USD is converting 73.1 percent (144-197) from the foul line...The Coyotes own an 8-0 record when leading at halftime this season. In seven of the nine games, USD has scored more than 75 points (all wins)...The Coyotes have hit double digits in made three-point field goals on four occasions; including a season-best 14-of-24 performance against Colorado Christian (97-80 win)...The 97 points scored against Colorado Christian is the highest total by a USD women's team since the Coyotes defeated Chadron State, 104-62, in the 2003-04 season...Bridget Yoerger, who set a career best with 15 rebounds vs. Wayne State on Dec. 16, also had 17 points in recording her second career double double. She leads the Coyotes in scoring at 13.6 per game. She also averaged a team high 7.6 rebounds per game...Shannon Daly had career best with 14 points and seven rebounds in the win over Wayne State on Saturday. She also contributed five assists and recorded three steals.
