Three NCC Teams Get Second Life - Three NCC teams were among the 64 teams selected to the NCAA Division II Women's Basketball Championship when the bracket was announced late Sunday night. South Dakota, regular-season and tournament NCC champ, is the #1 seed and will host the tournament. North Dakota received the second seed while Minnesota State is the sixth seed. Augustana, the eighth-ranked team in the region entering the week, was left out of the field primarily because unranked Colorado State-Pueblo won the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference tournament and received the automatic berth from that league...Minnesota State gets a rematch with Concordia-St. Paul from earlier this season in which Concordia was the 76-64 victor. Overall CSP was 3-0 against the NCC with wins over Minnesota State, Minnesota Duluth and St. Cloud State...North Dakota faces Wayne St. in the first round. The two teams did not meet this season, but the NCC was 1-1 against Wayne St. this year with South Dakota posting a 1-point victory and Augustana suffering a loss...South Dakota gets Colorado State-Pueblo. CSU-P dropped games to Nebraska-Omaha and Augustana at a UNO tournament earlier in the year in the only matchups with the NCC.

The Notebook

Augustana - Augustana saw its season come to an end Sunday night when the Vikings were not selected to participate in the North Central Regional Tournament. The Vikings, who were ranked eighth in the region last week, lost in the semifinals of the NCC Tournament. However, unranked Colorado State-Pueblo won the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference Tournament and earned an automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament... Ashley Holiday ended her career 15th on the Augustana career scoring with 1,249 points and 6th on the career rebounds chart with 835. In addition, her school-record 310 blocked shots rank her 13th in Division II history.

Minnesota Duluth - UMD's senior trio of Katy Freeman, Alissa Pauly and Kim Wagers tallied eight points apiece in their final collegiate basketball game, a 69-61 loss to North Dakota in the first-round of the NCC tournament last Wednesday...Freeman averaged a team-high 13.3 points per game this season, tallying 359 points during her senior campaign. Freeman tallied 642 points in her two seasons with UMD after transferring from NCAA Division I Southern Illinois...Pauly led the team in assists this season with a 3.6 assists per game average. She had 96 assists in total during her senior campaign and finishes her career with 334 assists and 511 points...Wagers was second on the team in rebounding this season with a 5.4 rebounds per game average and 145 total rebounds. For her career, Wagers pulled down 467 rebounds.

Minnesota State - Minnesota State is making its first trip to the NCAA Division II regional for the first time since 1986...G Heather Johnson scored 22 points against USD in the NCC semifinals. She has reached the 20 point plateau in 15 games this season...MSU takes on Concordia-St. Paul in the first round of the NCAA tournament. MSU owns a 5-8 all-time record against CSP with the Golden Bears winning the most recent meeting on Dec. 18, 76-64...MSU has four players averaging more than ten points per game in G Heather Johnson (17.1), G Jo Noreen (12.8), G Tiffany Moe (10.6), and FAlex Andrews (10.2).

Nebraska-Omaha - UNO ended its season at 17-12 after an 81-66 loss in the first round of the NCC post-season tournament at Augustana last week. It marked the third straight winning season for the Mavericks under four-year head coach Patty Patton Shearer. The Mavericks are 67-49 over that span and have not had a losing season after going 14-14 in her first year...G Alyssa Green led the team in scoring, averaging 14.1 points per game, as well as steals and assists.

St. Cloud State - St. Cloud State finished its final season in the NCC with an 11-17 overall record and 3-9 league mark, good for fifth place...Fifth-seeded Huskies fell to #4-seed Minnesota State, 73-71 in the NCC tournament quarterfinal, bringing the season to an end...F Kayla Rengel brought her collegiate career to an end with 15 points, eight rebounds and two blocks...She scored 1,292 points in her career, which ranks her 15th on the SCSU all-time career scoring chart...The Huskies have been members of the NCC since the 1984-85 season...SCSU shared the NCC title (NDSU) in 1988-89 with an 11-3 record...Twice during that span, the Huskies boasted the NCC Player of the Year... In 2007, it was Erika Quigley, SCSU's all-time scoring and rebounding leader...in 1996, it was Brenda Meyer.

South Dakota - USD won the school's first-ever NCC Tournament Championship with a 72-69 decision over North Dakota on Sunday...South Dakota ended a string of seven consecutive tournament championships by North Dakota...The Coyotes, ranked third in NCAA Division II, won for the 26th straight time and earned the league's automatic berth to the NCAA Division II playoffs...USD's 28 wins this season breaks the school record of 27-5 set by the 2002-03 team, also coach by Chad Lavin. In addition, the Coyotes won the regular season crown (12-0) and the NCC Tournament in the same year for the first time...In addition, The U extended its home winning streak to 19 games. Hoffman, who tied a season-high with six three-point field goals, was named the NCC Tournament MVP...In a season when USD has struggled at times at the free throw line, it was their work at the foul line that made the difference in the title game against North Dakota. South Dakota, which averages 68.7 percent from the foul line, made all seven attempts against UND, including two by Bridget Yoerger with nine seconds left in the game...Jeana Hoffman increased her season total for points to 512, which ranks fifth all-time at USD. She had 20 points for the 18th time of her career...The Coyotes had a solid weekend from the perimeter. Against UND, they made 13-of-32 shots from three-point range for 40.6 percent. In the two games of the tournament, the Coyotes converted 25-of-56 shots for 44.6 percent from three-point range. USD also ended North Dakota's 18-game NCC Tournament winning streak.
