Offensive Players of the Week

Amos Allen of South Dakota, Ted Schlafke of Minnesota Duluth and Weston Dressler of North Dakota have been named the NCC Offensive Players of the Week.

Allen, a senior running back from Miami, Fla., set a school record with 306 yards rushing on 32 attempts (9.6 ypc) and scored two touchdowns in USD's game with North Dakota.

Schlafke, a junior quarterback from Stevens Point, Wis., racked up 495 yards of total offense, a league-high for the year and the fourth highest total in league history, and was involved in a school and league-record 84 plays while helping lead UMD to a 23-13 win at St. Cloud State. He rushed 27 times for a career-best 145 yards and one touchdown (which put UMD ahead for good at 6-0) and added another 350 yards through the air, completing 37 of 57 passes while also running for a two-point conversion.

Dressler, a senior wide receiver from Bismarck, N.D., caught 10 passes for 148 yards and three touchdowns as UND snapped USD's 23-game home winning streak.

Dressler's 18-yard score in the fourth quarter stood as the deciding points as UND snapped USD's school-record 23-game home winning streak. In fact, all three of Dressler's touchdowns gave UND the lead.

Others nominated: Nate Wurth, Nebraska-Omaha; Ben King, Minnesota State.

Jeff Souder of Nebraska-Omaha and Brett Holinka of North Dakota have been named the NCC Defensive Players of the Week.

Souder, a junior outside linebacker from Bellevue, Neb., tallied 11 tackles (9 solo, 2 assist), including one sack for a loss of six yards and also returned a fumble 44 yards as UNO completed its first undefeated season since 1954 with a win over Central Washington.

Holinka, a junior linebacker from Dickinson, N.D., led all players with a career-high 13 tackles (three solo) and a pair of quarterback sacks. His sacks came on back-to-back plays on 3rd and 4th down with less than two minutes remaining once the Coyotes had driven to UND's 11-yard line, nullifying a potential game-winning drive.

UNO Wins Title - With their win over Central Washington Nebraska-Omaha claimed the NCC title for the fourth consecutive season and completed its first undefeated season since 1954. UNO is the top seed for the NCAA Division II Football Championship in the Northwest Region.

Three Teams Advance - Three NCC teams were among the six teams chosen to represent the Northwest Region in the NCAA Division II Football Championship. Top-seed Nebraska-Omaha will have a first-round bye and host the winner of the #4-seed Central Washington vs. #5-seed Ashland game on November 24. The CWU/AU game will take place Saturday in Ellensburg, Wash. #3-seed North Dakota will host #6-seed Winona State Saturday with the winner getting a trip to face #2-seed and reigning NCAA DII champion Grand Valley State on November 24.

King is King of NCC Passing Records - Minnesota State's Ben King set a bevy of NCC records during his career. He set new NCC season passing marks in attempts (459, old record 377), completions (272, old record 220) and passing yards (3144, old record 2584) and average completions per game (34.0, old record 31.43). He also set new NCC career marks in passing attempts (1212, old record 1141), pass completions (697, old record 676), average completions per game (25.81, old record 21.1) and fell only 62 yards shy of the NCC record for career passing yards, which is remarkable considering that he played fewer games than Eric DeGraff of Augustana (1997-2000). He also set (or tied) the game record for pass attempts twice, finally landing on 68 vs. Western Washington.

The Notebook

AUGUSTANA - Two Viking seniors ended their careers with some impressive accomplishments. Wide receiver Tommy Ellingworth finished with 210 career receptions for 2,367 yards. Both of those totals rank No. 2 on Augustana's career charts. Dustin Rice left his name in the NCC record book by tying 1 NCC record and breaking another. He had 2 interceptions returned for touchdowns in NCC play to tie the league record for a season. That brought his career total to 4 interceptions returned for touchdowns, which is a new NCC career record.

CENTRAL WASHINGTON - Central Washington was selected to the NCAA Division II playoffs for the second time in nine seasons as a NCAA member on Sunday. The Wildcats, 8-2 overall and the third-place team in the NCC with a 6-2 conference mark, will host Ashland (Ohio) in the first round this coming Saturday...The Wildcats own a 10-9-1 all-time postseason record, which includes a co-championship at the NAIA Division II level in 1995...Central suffered its largest loss since the 2000 season opener on Saturday against Nebraska-Omaha. The 59-21 loss to the Mavericks was the greatest margin of defeat since a 52-7 loss at North Dakota seven years ago...The 59 points allowed were the second-most in school history, trailing only a 61-point performance by Boise State against the Wildcats in 1968...Central QB Mike Reilly, who was named a candidate for the Harlon Hill Trophy on Friday, became the third Wildcat signal caller with 8,000 or more career passing yards...RB Johnny Lopez broke the 1,000-yard mark in rushing on the season, becoming the 10th player in school history with that milestone.

MINNESOTA DULUTH - The Bulldogs closed out their 75th year of football in winning fashion by besting St. Cloud State University 23-12 Saturday afternoon in St. Cloud, Minn ... In that win — UMD's third straight over the Huskies, junior quarterback generated 495 yards of total offense (13 yards shy of his team single-game record) and became the first Bulldog in over two years and 26 games to eclipse the 100-yard rushing barrier. Schlafke's 84 total plays on the day bested his previous team record of 78 which he set in the 2005 NCAA II playoffs against North Dakota. ...Schlafke also finished the year as UMD's leading rusher — just the second quarterback to ever do so — with an even 500 yards on 176 carries ... Brett Baumann, one of 11 seniors on the 2007 UMD roster, booted three fields goals Saturday and closed out his playing days equaling Bulldog career records for both field goals made (28) and attempted (48) — marks he shares with Chad Gerlach (2000-03) ... Junior cornerback Cole Strilzuk made his first collegiate start Saturday in St. Cloud and responded by returning an interception — his first as a Bulldog — 84 yards for a touchdown to help seal the victory ... Senior wide out Brandon Anson ranked first among the 2007 Bulldogs in receiving with 69 catches and, in the process, established a club record for average receptions per game (6.9) ... In the 23-13 triumph at St. Cloud, Senior inside linebacker and four-year starter Nate Fears topped UMD with 11 total tackles and closed out his career stationed in the No. 5 spot on the Bulldogs' career defensive charts with 240 stops.

MINNESOTA STATE - MSU kicker Jason Tompkins kicked a pair of field goals in MSU's win over Western Washington, marking the first time since Oct. 14, 2006 (against Minne-

sota Duluth) that MSU has kicked two or more field goals in a game...QB Ben King completed 40-of-54 passes (.740) against Western Washington, the highest pass completion percentage (min. 20 attempts) in MSU history...King threw all five touchdowns in the first half against Western Washington...King also passed John Hebgen on the school's all-time touchdown passes list, finishing his career with 72 scoring strikes...His 429 yards passing marked the seventh time in his career that King has thrown for more than 400 yards...Today's total is the fifth-highest single-game performance in MSU history...King closed his career with MSU by completing 942-of-1,641 passes for 11,035 yards...His 11,035 yards ties him with Bentley's Marc Eddy (2001-04) for sixth on the NCAA Division II all-time chart...King connected with sophomore Chris Nowlin for a 61-yard scoring strike against WWU, marking his longest completion of the year.

NEBRASKA-OMAHA - UNO will be making its fourth straight playoff appearance when it hosts a second-round game on Nov. 24 at 1 p.m. at Caniglia Field. The Mavericks will also be hosting their third-straight second-round contest. The Mavericks will play the winner of Saturday's Ashland-Central Washington game, and if it's CWU, it will be the first time in school history to play the same team in back-to-back games...UNO's 59-point outburst Saturday marked the sixth 40-plus-point game this year, a first for the school. Twice before UNO teams had scored 40-plus five times, in 1998 and 1999...Brian McNeill moved up to fourth-place on the school's single-season rushing chart, currently standing at 1,351...Keith Eloi's 80-yard kickoff return for a score was the first for a Maverick since MarTay Jenkins in 1998 returned a kick 89 yards for a score at Morningside. Jenkins went on to set NFL kickoff return records for yards and average with the Arizona Cardinals.

ST. CLOUD STATE - St. Cloud State finished the 2007 season with a 4-7 overall record and a 1-7 record in the NCC...SCSU competed in the North Central Conference in football for 25 years beginning with a 4-5 league record in 1983 and a 1-7 league mark in 2007...SCSU posted a 98-114 NCC mark over 25 years and won two NCC Championships, the first in 1989 with an 8-1 record and the second in 2002 with a 6-2 record...the Huskies also advanced to the NCAA playoffs twice during their stint in the NCC, the first in 1989 when SCSU posted a 27-20 win over Augustana College followed by a 55-24 loss to Mississippi College in games played at Selke Field...in 2004 the Huskies opened Husky Stadium on the SCSU campus and hosted North Dakota in a first round playoff, losing to North Dakota 20-17 in overtime...Noel Martin coached the Huskies from 1983 to 1998 and Randy Hedberg just completed his ninth season as head coach of the Huskies...SCSU All-American running back Harry Jackson (1986-89) was the first played in the NCC to rush for over 4,000 yards in league games, and the first to rush for 1,000 yards in three consecutive seasons...He rushed for 4,212 yards in NCC game and still holds the NCC single game rushing record of 337 yards recorded against USD in 1989...Jackson was SCSU's all-time rushing leader with 4,889 yards until Matt Birkel (2002-05) broke the mark in 2005 and holds the record of 4,920 rushing yards.

SOUTH DAKOTA - USD's loss to UND snaps South Dakota's 23-game home winning streak. The streak started on November 15, 2003 when the Coyotes defeated Lincoln University 56-7. During the streak they outscored their opponents 1,017 to 335. This is the first loss for head coach Ed Meierkort at DakotaDome (22-1) and for the USD seniors it is their only home loss of their career...Amos Allen broke two school records in the game. He set the South Dakota single game record for rushing yards with 306 yards and scored two touchdowns. The previous record was held by Stefan Logan who ran for 295 yards in 2005 against Truman State. Allen also broke the USD single season rushing record, as he finished the season with 1,961 rushing yards. Jamel White set the record in 1999 when he ran for 1,796 yards...In addition to the records that he broke, Allen also finished the season as the leading rusher in the nation...Frank Leibfarth also re-wrote Coyote history. With his two field goals and three PATs, he tied Jason Leber for the USD career scoring record. Both players finished their careers with 236 points. Leibfarth finishes his career with 27 field goals and 155 extra points...WR Brooks Little added to his career receptions record and also moved into second place on the USD career receiving yards list. He had two catches for 29 yards in the game. The career receptions record now stands at 164. His 29 receiving yards moved him past Chris Mikkelsen (2001-04) into second place on the Coyote career receiving yards list. Rod Tweet (1983-85) holds the record with 2,557 yards...For the second week in a row, Tyler Bergan finished in double-digits in tackles to lead the Coyote defense. He recorded 11 tackles in the game, one week after recording a career-high 14 against Nebraska-Omaha. Justiss Scales added six tackles and a sack.
