Players of the Week

Jake Morrow
 Minnesota State

Nick Olson
 Augustana

Jake Morrow of Minnesota State and Nick Olson of Augustana have been named the North Central Conference Players of the Week.

Morrow, a sophomore forward from Wild Rose, Wis., averaged 21.0 points, 5.5 rebounds and 3.0 steals per game in wins over Concordia (Moorhead) and Carleton.

Morrow shot .593 (16x27) from the field, including being successful on 8 of 14 three-point attempts (.571). He posted a career-high 28 points against Concordia, the highest total for a Maverick sophomore since 2004.

Olson, a senior forward from Eden Prairie, Minn., averaged 16.0 points, 8.5 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.8 steals per game in a quartet of wins over Wayne State, Illinois Tech, Upper Iowa and Southwest Minnesota State.

Olson hit 24 of 44 shots from the floor (.545) and 11 of 15 free throws (.733). His 24 points against Upper Iowa is a career high and his 12 rebounds in the same game is a season-high performance.

Conference Up Next - The North Central Conference season finally gets underway Thursday and will continue weekly on Thursdays and Saturdays until the NCC Championship gets underway with the first round on February 28.

Vastly Improved - North Central Conference men's teams have a much better record against non-conference opponents than they did at this time last season. NCC teams hold a 74-28 (.725) record against the non-conference foes this year while they only had a 66-35 (.646) mark at this time last year. More importantly the NCC has a 30-12 (.714) record against the Northern Sun so far this season. During the 2005-06 season the NCC was only able to manage a 22-22 mark.

NOTEBOOK

Augustana - With a 13-2 non-conference record, Augustana is off to its best start in nearly 20 years. The Vikings have already eclipsed last year's win total of 12 and have their eye on the first 20-win season since the 1988-89 campaign. With a victory over UNO, Augustana would match the 14-2 start of the 1987-88 squad. Incidentally, the Vikings advanced to the regional tournament in both of those seasons...Nick Olson is now 23rd on the Vikings' career scoring chart with 1,054 points. He became the 25th player in Augustana history to score 1,000 career points when he scored 11 points against Illinois Tech.

Minnesota State - MSU has played to a 19-13 record in North Central Conference lidlifters...Since the opening of the Taylor Center, MSU has played to a 4-2 record in the Taylor Center in NCC home openers, while head coach Matt Margenthaler is 4-1 in NCC home openers...Since UMD joined the league, the two schools have opened NCC play against each other each year...Minnesota State and Minnesota Duluth share eight common opponents this season. Both schools earned wins against Dominican, Felician, Minnesota Crookston and Southwest Minnesota State. Minnesota Duluth split its two games against Michigan Tech, while MSU downed MTU in their only game against each other. UMD also lost to Northern Michigan, a team MSU beat; however UMD downed Concordia-St. Paul. MSU's only loss of the season came to CSP...Minnesota State is in the midst of a 12-game home winning streak, a mark that is tied for the longest in the history of the Taylor Center...Minnesota State has won 12 consecutive games, a mark that is tied the third-longest single-season winning streak in school history...Over the past two seasons, MSU has played to a 12-2 (.857) record in the year's first month...G Luke Anderson has made 28 of his last 31 (90.3%) free throws, including his last 19...Jake Morrow's 28 points against Concordia-Moorhead marks just the second time this season that player not named Anderson scored 20 or more points in a game...The Mavericks have used five different starting lineups this year.

St. Cloud State - G David Dreas scored his 1,000th career point on Sunday against Northern Michigan. He heads into the NCC opener with 1,006 career points and is the 32nd Husky to reach 1,000. Dreas equaled his season high with 30 points at Minnesota-Crookston last Friday. He scored 20 first half points, including 18 straight points for the Huskies in the final six and a half minutes of the half...SCSU head coach Kevin Schlagel recorded his 190th career win on Friday. He ranks third in all-time wins on the SCSU coaching chart, behind Red Severson (209) and Butch Raymond (231)...F Brett Carmichael has gained more playing time over the last five games. He had a career outing against NMU on Sunday with six points (equals career high) and a career high eight rebounds. He scored the game tying basket in regulation and four of his six points in the overtime frame...G Dusty Wabiszewski scored a career high 16 points at Bowie State and had a career high eight rebounds at Columbia Union...the Huskies are 6-3 in NCC openers under head coach Kevin Schlagel...the Huskies eight game win streak matched an eight game win streak last season.

South Dakota - The Coyotes have won seven straight games, the longest such streak for the program since the 2004-05 team had an 11-game winning streak...All of USD's wins during this streak have been by at least 11 points...South Dakota was a perfect 7-0 in December...USD's 60-point margin of victory over Illinois Tech (12/28) was the largest since the Coyotes defeated Morningside by 67 points in 2001-02...Through a quirk in a schedule, the Coyotes will have only one game per week during the first three weeks of North Central Conference play, which begins this week...In each of the last two games, all 10 South Dakota players that dressed for the game scored.
