Players of the Week

Zac Robinson
Nebraska-Omaha

Marques Blank
Augustana

Zac Robinson of Nebraska-Omaha and Marques Blank of Augustana have been named the North Central Conference Players of the Week.

Robinson, a senior guard from Omaha, Neb., averaged 20.7 points, 5.7 rebounds, 1.7 assists and 1.0 steals per game in wins over Peru State, Regis and Colorado State-Pueblo.

He shot .517 (15x29) from three-point range and .692 (9x13) from the free throw line to go along with a .388 (19x49) clip from the field.

Blank, sophomore guard from Holmen, Wis., shot a blistering .636 percent from the field (7x11), including a 4-5 effort from 3-point range last week in leading the Vikings to big wins over Nebraska-Kearney and Missouri Southern State.

Against Nebraska-Kearney, Blank was 6-for-7 from the field and 3-for-3 from 3-point range. He followed that up with a career-high 13-assist performance against Missouri Southern State, more than doubling his previous career high of 6 assists. He averaged 9 assists per game this week.

Others nominated: Tony Thomason, Minnesota State; Jordan Nuness, Minnesota Duluth; Emmanuel Little, North Dakota.

NOTEBOOK

Augustana - Augustana improved to 6-1 on the season with big home wins over Nebraska-Kearney (81-69) and Missouri Southern State (85-76) last week, extending their winning streak to 5 games. The Vikings' 6-1 start is its best start since the 1999-2000 team started 8-1 with a pair of 4-game winning streaks during that stretch. The 5-game winning streak is the longest since the 1995-96 season. That year, the Vikings had 2 5-game winning streaks...Marques Blank shattered his career high in assists against Missouri Southern State. He dished out 13 assists in the Viking win, more than doubling his previous career high of 6...Augustana shot a season-best 56.6 percent (30-for-53) to defeat Nebraska-Kearney, which was ranked No. 15 in the NABC Preseason Top 25 Poll. The Vikings have now shot better than 50 percent in their last 3 contests...After a Tuesday home game against Peru State, the Vikings will travel to Alaska for games this weekend against Alaska-Anchorage and Alaska-Fairbanks.

Minnesota State - Over the past four games, G Tony Thomason has led all Mavericks in scoring as he is averaging 15.8 points per game...He is shooting a scorching 55.3 percent from the floor and a red-hot 59.1 from the three-point line...He also leads the team in minutes played (32.8) during that span...A 3-0 week would give head coach Matt Margenthaler his 100th career win...The Maverick bench averaged 13.3 points per game this week, led by F Mitch Gosson, who averaged 5.3 points and 6.0 rebounds per game...More importantly, the Maverick bench turned the ball over just seven times this week.

St. Cloud State - The Huskies will hit the road this week for only the second and third road games of the season. SCSU is 1-0 on the road this year after last week's win at Bemidji State. Huskies travel to Upper Iowa on Tuesday and play crosstown rival St. John's University on Saturday...SCSU has won four straight games, include three wins last week...G David Dreas tallied 60 points over the week, including a season-high 27 points against Minnesota State Moorhead.

South Dakota - South Dakota has not had consecutive wins or losses through eight games...The Coyotes begin a four-game homestand Monday against Morningside. It is USD's longest homestand since the 2004-05 season...F Eric Hall and G/FDylan Grimsley have each reached double-digits in scoring in all eight games this year...USD will look to exact revenge on former NCC-rival Morningside on Monday. Last season, the Mustangs snapped the Coyotes' 85-game home non-conference winning streak with an 83-82 victory gained on a last-second basket.
