Offensive Player of the Week Vicky Braegelmann Minnesota Duluth

Vicky Braegelmann of Minnesota Duluth has been named the Offensive Player of the Week by the North Central Conference.

Braegelmann, a junior from Albany, Minn., hit .461 (60k-13e-102ta) as the Bulldogs posted a 3-1 record at the Colorado Premier Tournament. She averaged 4.29 kills per game.

Augustana - Three of Augustana's six losses have come in 5 games...Andrea Oswald has had at least 20 kills in 4 matches this season and is hitting .321 on the year...Blythe Johnson has had at least 4 blocks in her last 6 matches...Abby Schmidt averaged 6.0 digs per game at the Colorado Premier.

Nebraska-Omaha - At 7-0, Mavericks are off to their best start since the 2000 season when they started with 15 straight wins...UNO is 6-0 against MIAA opponents with four more MIAA teams on tap this week...Carlie Christensen, Christina Reicks, and Stacie Wemhoff were named to the all-tournament team at the Missouri Western Invitational.

South Dakota - Libero Amber Kobus had a career-high 41 digs against Northern State...Middle blocker Heather Hult posted a career-high 17 kills and had a .455 hitting percentage in the win over Upper Iowa...USD had 95 digs compared to just 66 by MSU Moorhead as the Coyotes rallied from a 2-1 deficit to win the match 3-2...USD picked up the 300th victory in the history of the program when they rallied to defeat MSU Moorhead on Saturday 3-2.
