Ellen Thommes of Nebraska-Omaha and Ashley Nachreiner of Minnesota State have been named the Offensive Players of the Week by the North Central Conference.

Thommes, a freshman middle blocker from Omaha, Neb., hit .514 (22k-3e-37ta) while averaging 3.67 kills and .33 services aces per game against Upper Iowa and South Dakota.

Nachreiner, a sophomore outside hitter from Round Rock, Texas, hit .444 (28k-4e-54ta) with an average of 4.00 kills and .29 service aces per game against Winona St. and North Dakota.

Bulldogs Claim Crown - Minnesota Duluth has locked up the NCC title for the third straight season, meaning the the Bulldogs have won the NCC title in each of the years that they have been members of the league. UMD sports a 31-3 mark in NCC play since joining the league in 2004. If UMD is able to defeat St. Cloud State and North Dakota this week they will become the first team to sport an undefeated NCC mark since 1991 when North Dakota State had a 9-0 mark. No team has been able to survive a double round-robin NCC schedule without obtaining a loss since the league went to the format in 1994.

The Notebook

AUGUSTANA - Despite sitting second in the North Central Conference standings and sixth in the regional rankings, Augustana is faced with a must-win situation. At 13-12 with scheduled matches this week at Nebraska-Omaha and Minnesota State, the Vikings must win 1 of those matches to be eligible for the regional tournament...Ellen Andrews has reached double figures in kills in 4 straight matches and 9 out of her last 13 outings. She matched her career high of 15 kills against Minnesota Duluth on Saturday...Abby Schmidt has recorded at least 20 digs in 3 straight matches and 4 of the last 5 matches...Andrea Oswald had 8 kills and 9 blocks against Minnesota Duluth despite missing the fourth game due to injury...Terrin Post has registered double figures in kills in 23 of 25 matches this season with a current streak of 8 matches. Post has led the team or tied for the team lead in kills in the past 7 matches

MINNESOTA DULUTH - Minnesota Duluth went 1-1 this past week, falling in four games to Concordia-St. Paul before bouncing back to defeat Augustana College on the Bulldogs home court later in the week. With the win, UMD claimed its third-straight NCC crown. In two matches this week, senior Rachel Langseth pounded down 31 kills. Senior libero Chelsea Meierotto came up with 42 digs in the two matches and sophomore setter Katie Gangelhoff dished out 118 assists.

MINNESOTA STATE - Middle hitter Cathy Turner had a season-high 16 kills in Tuesday's win over Winona State. Turner currently leads the team with a .304 attack percentage...Outside hitter Dana Ostertag posted a career-high 16 digs against Winona....Outside hitter Ashley Nachreiner totaled a team-high 28 kills in matches against Winona and North Dakota last week, hitting .444. With 216 kills, Nachreiner currently ranks second on the team...Setter Stef Sandstrom recorded her team-leading 16th double-double of the season with 49 assists and 12 digs...Outside hitter Lisa Rohret led the Mavericks with 16 digs against Winona and 25 against North Dakota.

NEBRASKA-OMAHA - Christina Reicks leads the Mavericks with 18 double-doubles on the year....Carlie Christensen has hit .400 or better in 12 matches this season. She has hit .500 or better in seven matches...Katie Agnew currently ranks 13th on the UNO career records chart with 1,104 assists...Carlie Christensen ranks 10th on the UNO career records chart with 290 block assists...Stacie Wemhoff has 1,000 career digs which ranks 20th on the UNO career charts.

NORTH DAKOTA - Within NCC play the team earned a split with Minnesota State and St. Cloud State...This was another week of milestones for the Sioux...Aileen Cahill reached another feat in Fighting Sioux volleyball history...During Friday nights match, Cahill recorded her 1,000 career kill. Cahill is now the sixth member in Fighting Sioux history to accomplish both 1,000 career kills and 1,000 career digs...This past week saw some impressive performances by Sioux volleyball players...Setter Allison Louwagie finished this past week with 146 set assists for an average of 14.60 set assists per game...Middle hitter Tara Holmen slammed home 42 kills for an average of 4.20 kills per game...Holmen also averaged 1.6 blocks per game...Libero Lindsay Vortherms averaged 5.40 digs per game...The Sioux have one final regular season match and that is against conference leader Minnesota Duluth on Saturday.

ST. CLOUD STATE - The Huskies bring an overall record of 8-19 and an NCC record of 1-8 into tonight's match (Monday, Oct. 30) against Minnesota Duluth...Outside hitter Lindsey Gothe has now tallied over 1,000 digs and 1,000 kills in her four-year collegiate career...Currently Gothe ranks 5th on the all-time career digs list at SCSU with 1009 in 314 games played....Right side hitter Kristi Pangrac leads the Huskies with 367 kills (3.63 kpg) and a .304 hitting percentage in 2006...Team co-captains Lindsey Gothe, Sierra Nowak and Deanna Pieper will all play in their final home match tonight against UMD.

SOUTH DAKOTA - The Coyotes ended a 14-match losing streak by sweeping Minnesota-Crookston on Friday night. It was the first time that USD won a match this year in three games...USD's final two matches this season come at home this week, when it hosts Wayne State (Neb.) on Halloween night before concluding the year against St. Cloud State on Friday night...South Dakota needs to defeat the Huskies on Friday to avoid its first winless NCC campaign since 1999.
