UMD Tops Regional Rankings - The NCAA published region rankings for first time this season and Minnesota Duluth holds the top spot and five of the NCC's seven teams were ranked in the top eight. The NCC holds the top spot in each of the fall sports (football, volleyball and soccer) in the first week of the rankings.

The Notebook

AUGUSTANA - With 16 wins this season, Augustana has eclipsed the 15 wins the Vikings have reached in each of the past 2 seasons...Cayla Schroeder has recorded 13 double-doubles this season, including in 10 of her last 11 outings...Beth Talcott has played well of late. She has at least 8 kills in her last 4 matches. Her 11 kills against North Dakota was the fourth time this season she has reached double figures in kills.

MINNESOTA DULUTH - UMD's mastery over its NCC rivals continued this past weekend as the Bulldogs dispatched Minnesota State Friday in three games... The Bulldogs then went on to blast their way past St. Cloud State Saturday in three games to improve to 21-1 on the season and a perfect 8-0 in the NCC...S Katie Gangelhoff paced the Bulldog offense with 102 assists on the weekend, with 46 coming against MSU-Mankato and 56 against SCSU...MB Sarah Wyffels hit a scorching .449 for the weekend, averaging 4.17 kills per game while tallying 25 for the two matches...L Crystal Hoffrogge recorded 33 digs in the two matches, averaging 5.50 digs per game...UMD has not lost a league match since Oct. 21, 2005 which came at the hands of Nebraska-Omaha...The Bulldogs current win streak represents a span of 26 league matches in a row.

MINNESOTA STATE - Minnesota State was defeated by Concordia-St. Paul Tuesday in a five-game match and was swept by Minnesota Duluth in three Friday...This brings the Mavericks overall record to 15-5 with a 3-2 North Central Conference record...The loss to Concordia-St. Paul ended a three-match winning streak for Minnesota State...Amanda Beekman notched 21 of her 29 kills against Concordia-St. Paul...Minnesota States next match comes against South Dakota, Tuesday in Mankato.

NEBRASKA-OMAHA - MB Carlie Christensen has moved up to fourth on the Maverick career charts with 389 block assists. She ranks 15th with 1,099 career kills...S Katie Agnew ranks 8th with 2,025 career set assists...With her second kill against Northwest Missouri State on Sept. 19, Carlie Christensen became the 16th player in school history to record 1,000 career kills. The senior from Omaha has now tallied 1,099 kills to date.

NORTH DAKOTA - Augustana and Nebraska-Omaha defeated UND during this weekend's NCC play...UND lost 3-0 in both games this weekend...Against Augustana Tara Holmen and Amanda Polzin each tallied 11 kills. L Courtney Halvorson totaled 15 digs in the contest...In the UNO match, North Dakota hit .037 as a team compared to UNO's .170. Amanda Polzin knocked home 10 kills to lead UND. L Courtney Halvorson finished with 20 digs in the contest. S Megan Langseth recorded her third double-double of the season against UNO. Langseth finished with 26 set assists and 15 digs...Halvorson now has reached double-digit dig totals in five straight games...UND returns home to face St. Cloud State Saturday.

ST. CLOUD STATE - The Huskies play host to Valley City State on Tuesday in Halenbeck Hall before returning to NCC action for a match against North Dakota.

SOUTH DAKOTA - USD, which received votes (13) in the most recent AVCA poll, remains just one win away from tying the school's all-time season win mark of 18 which was established by the 1976, 1977, 2003 and 2004 teams. The 2003 and 2004 (both 18-10) squads were coached by Lamppa. The all-time mark for winning percentage was established by Jan Whitman's 1976 squad which finished 18-7 for a mark of .720...The Coyotes stand 17-5 on the season, which represents a significant turnaround from a year ago when the Coyotes were 6-22...Amber Kobus had a team, season-high of 40 digs in the 3-2 loss to Wayne State Saturday. The 40 digs by Kobus was just one off her all-time match record of 41 and gives her 431 on the season or 5.31 per match. She has moved into 10th on USD's single season all-time chart. In addition, she has moved into fourth place all-time at USD with 1,321 career digs...Ashley Gross has totaled 754 career kills which ranks ninth on USD's career list...With 1,017 set assists, setter Gina Baldwin ranks ninth on USD's single season chart. She has 1,397 career assists which ranks eight all-time at USD.
