UMD Tops Regional Rankings - The NCAA published region rankings for first time this season and Minnesota Duluth holds the top spot and five of the NCC's seven teams were ranked in the top eight. The NCC holds the top spot in each of the fall sports (football, volleyball and soccer).

The Notebook

AUGUSTANA - Beth Talcott put together the best match of her young career against Minnesota State. She pounded 22 kills and only 2 errors for a .303 attack percentage in the 4-game loss to MSU. Her 22 kills, along with her 22 digs were both career highs. In her last 5 matches, Talcott is averaging 3.32 kills and 4.05 digs per game...Cayla Schroeder had the first 30-dig match of her career against Minnesota State. Her 35 digs was a career high. In addition, she was involved in 4 blocks.

NORTH DAKOTA - UND played in only one match and lost to St. Cloud State in a five-game match...UND jumped to a 2-1 lead, but the Huskies came back to win games four and five to seal the NCC victory...Against St. Cloud State, UND had many players finish with career highs...S Megan Langseth finished with a career-high 64 set assists...Langseth also recorded her fourth double-double of the season by recording 23 digs in the contest...Amanda Polzin tallied 24 kills in the contest, a career-high...L Courtney Halvorson notched a career-high 27 digs in the match...UND had four different players record double-figure kill totals and had five different players record at least 20 digs in the contest...UND will hit the road against Minnesota Crookston Tuesday and Concordia-St. Paul Friday, before traveling to playing South Dakota in NCC action.

ST. CLOUD STATE - Head coach Patricia Mickow currently has 299 career wins, and will go for number 300 when the Huskies take on Winona State Tuesday. The first serve is set for 7:00 p.m. in WSU's McCown Gymnasium...S Jennifer Waterman broke SCSU's first-year, single-season record of 859 assists, set by Rachael Olson in 1996. She also posted a season-high eight kills against VCSU. On the week, Watermen helped lead the Huskies to two wins, and totaled 88 set assists on the week. Waterman now leads SCSU with 929 set assists in 88 games played...L Andreaana Pieper posted an individual season-best 37 digs against North Dakota in the Husky win Saturday at the Betty Engelstad Sioux Center. Pieper has now set a new school record for most digs in a season with 522 currently in 2007.

SOUTH DAKOTA - USD broke the school record for wins in a season with a 3-0 decision over Northern State Saturday. With the victory, USD improved its record to 19-6 on the season. The 19 wins this season breaks the record of 18 held by USD teams in 1976 (18-7), 1977 (18-17), 2003 (18-10) and 2004 (18-10). Both the 2003 and 2004 squads were coached by current USD head coach Brian Lamppa...L Amber Kobus had 26 digs as she recorded double digits for the 25th straight match this season. She now has 1,386 digs in her career which ranks third on USD's career chart. Kobus, who owns the single season mark for digs in a season with 615 in 2006, has 503 digs this season which is the fourth best single season total in school history...Laura Slagter has recorded four straight double-doubles (digs, kills)...This season, USD has defeated five squads that have been or are currently ranked in the AVCA's top-25 poll. Most recently, the Coyotes upset 12th-ranked Minnesota State, 3-1, Tuesday. USD owns a 3-1 win over #10 Augustana on Oct. 5 as well as a 3-1 decision over Wayne State, a team that was ranked #23 earlier this season. USD has a 3-2 decision over #21 Emporia State on August 31 and a 3-1 win on August 25 over #18 Indianapolis. The wins over Emporia State and Indianapolis both were played at tournaments and count as neutral court wins.
