**UMD Wins Championship** - Minnesota Duluth has claimed their fourth consecutive NCC championship, one for each year they were in the league. The NCC volleyball title has been claimed four consecutive years twice before (UNO and NDSU), but never since the championship was determined by league standings and not the NCC tournament, which was discontinued in 1990. The field for the NCAA Division II Volleyball Championship will be announced on Monday, November 12 at 9 a.m.

### The Notebook

**AUGUSTANA** - Augustana snapped its only losing streak of the season, a 3-match skid, on Tuesday with a 3-0 sweep at Northern State...On Friday, the Vikings came close to upsetting Minnesota Duluth. Although the Bulldogs won the match in 4 games, Games 1 and 3 both ended 31-29 in favor of UMD. In Game 1, Augie had a game point at 29-28 and in Game 3, the Vikings led 29-27 but could not convert any of the 3 game points... Augustana concludes the regular season this weekend with matches at North Dakota Friday and at St. Cloud State Saturday.

**MINNESOTA DULUTH** - History has a way of repeating itself and that is exactly what happened Tuesday as No. 2-ranked Minnesota Duluth outlasted Concordia-St. Paul in five games (30-19, 36-34, 22-30, 20-30, 16-14) for the second time this season...The Bulldogs played in front of 2,312 screaming fans - the largest crowd to ever witness a volleyball match at UMD's Romano Gymnasium...UMD also saw another record set this week as RS Vicky Braegelmann blasted down 22 kills during the Bulldogs win over Augustana Friday to place her at 1,767 kills for her career, passing Callie Zwettler's record of 1,757 set from 2001-04...Minnesota Duluth also defeated Minnesota State Saturday to move to 26-1 and 11-0 in the NCC this season.

**MINNESOTA STATE** - Minnesota State defeated St. Cloud State in a three-game match by the scores of 30-20, 30-28 and 30-9. S Stef Sandstrom tallied 55 of her 84 assists in this match. OH Amanda Beekman tallied 21 kills while Dana Ostertag tallied 13 of her 30 digs during the week...Against Minnesota Duluth the Mavericks were swept by the scores of 30-24, 30-25 and 30-17. Stef Sandstrom led the team in assists with 29 while MH Megan Stroud led the team in kills with 11. Dana Ostertag tied for the team lead in digs with Stef Sandstrom with 17.

**NORTH DAKOTA** - UND ended its eight-game losing streak by beating non-conference opponent, Bemidji State, 3-1. Megan Langseth recorded her sixth double-double of the season...The Sioux returned to NCC play as they hosted Nebraska-Omaha and South Dakota...Against the Mavericks, North Dakota put up quite the fight, but in the end UNO proved to be too much for the Sioux as the Mavericks won in five games. Langseth recorded another double-double in the contest by finishing with 59 set assists and 11 digs...Amanda Polzin tallied a game-high 21 kills in the contest...As a team, UND finished 40 attack errors...UND lost in three straight games to USD, 31-29, 30-13, 30-24. Langseth tallied her third straight double-double, finishing with 26 set assists and 11 digs...it is the second time this season that Langseth has recorded a double-double in three straight games. On the season Langseth has eight double-doubles.

**ST. CLOUD STATE** - St. Cloud State look to snap a five-game slide on Friday when SCSU hosts South Dakota...SCSU leads the all-time series with USD, 31-12, dating back to 1979...Fifth-year head coach Patricia Mickow is still looking for her 300th career victory, as her all-time coaching record stands at 299-353 (19 years)... The Huskies will be celebrating Senior Night and Parent's Night on Friday and Saturday, Nov. 9-10...Lone senior MH RaeAnne Stanley will be honored on Friday against USD, and the Huskies will salute their parents on Saturday against Augustana at 4 p.m. before their last home match of the season.

**SOUTH DAKOTA** - USD, which has won three straight matches, continue to break the all-time wins record as the Coyotes have forged a 22-7 record and a 5-5 mark in league play...Kristin Krittenbrink recorded 15 kills and hit a career-best .545 to lead the Coyotes to a 3-0 win over North Dakota Saturday. That total by Krittenbrink was her second highest kills total this season...S Gina Baldwin recorded 39 assists against UND and now has 1,336 on the season which ties her for third on the all-time season list with Liz Lough (1993)...Kathleen Hruska has 443 kills which ranks fifth on the USD season chart. She is just nine away from fourth and 12 from third. With 20 kills, Hruska will move all the way to second on the chart...USD is on pace to set several USD team records including kills per game, set assists per game and hitting percentage...Heather Hult was 20<sup>th</sup> in the most recent NCAA statistics with a .370 hitting percentage and Gina Baldwin was 28<sup>th</sup> in set assists at 12.29.
