NORTH DAKOTA - Playing in its last two games in the NCC and at the Division II level, North Dakota lost to #17 Augustana and #16 Minnesota State...On Friday, Augustana beat UND 3-1. After losing the first two games of the match, the Sioux rebounded to win game three, 32-30, but Augustana was too much and won game four for the match victory. Britta Hanson had a team-high 16 kills in the match...Against Minnesota State, the Sioux could not match the Mavericks firepower. The Mavericks hit .423 in the contest and UND hit only .022. Playing in her final game, senior Mary Blume finished with a team-high seven kills...UND finished its season with a 6-23 overall record and 0-12 in the NCC. It is only the fourth time in team history that UND failed to win a conference game. The last time it happened was 2004 and before that was 1983 and 1984.

ST. CLOUD STATE - SCSU completed the 2007 season with a 10-21 overall record and a 2-10 mark in the North Central Conference...OH Emily Baldwin led the Huskies with 445 kills (4.20 kpg) in 106 games played...Andrea Pieper led the NCC with 5.95 digs per game in 2007 and now ranks second all-time at SCSU with 1324 digs in 322 games played...Both Baldwin and Pieper were named to the 2007 All-NCC Honorable Mention squad...The Huskies last NCC match in school history was played against Augustana College on Saturday, Nov. 10, in Halenbeck Hall.

SOUTH DAKOTA - The South Dakota volleyball team has qualified for the NCAA DII playoffs for the second time in school history. USD last made the playoffs in 2004 when the Coyotes had a 1-1 mark at the North Central Regional. USD finished the regular season with a 23-8 overall record and were 6-6 in NCC play. USD's Kathleen Hruska, a junior from Sioux Falls, S.D., became USD's 12th All-NCC honoree. Hruska averaged 4.12 kills per game in 2007 while totaling 465 kills this season, which is the second highest total in school history. She hit .344 which ranked 39th nationally and fourth in the NCC. In addition, Hruska averaged 0.93 blocks (15 solo, 90 block assists), which ranked eighth in the league. Hruska scored 542 points or 4.8 per game, a total which was third-best in the conference. Amber Kobus, a junior from Columbus, Neb., became just the second NCC player ever to earn consecutive Defensive Player of the Year honors. Kobus averaged 5.32 digs per game, which ranked third in the NCC and 60th in NCAA Division II. Kobus, who was also honorable mention All-NCC, ranked third in the NCC in service aces (0.44 per game, 50 total). This season, Kobus recorded 606 digs, which is the second highest season total in school history. She owns the single season mark of 615 (2006). Kobus also moved into second on USD's career digs list with 1,489.

Five NCC Teams Advance - Five of the seven NCC teams got a second life as they were selected to the field for the NCAA Division II Volleyball Championship earlier today. The play will begin with North Central Region action in Duluth on Thursday. Top-seed Minnesota Duluth will play #6 South Dakota, #4 Nebraska-Omaha will play #5 Augustana and #8 Minnesota State will face #3 Southwest Minnesota State. The other first round match features #7 Wayne State facing #2 Concordia-St. Paul. Winners will advance to play on Friday with the championship match slated for Saturday.

UMD Finishes Successful Four Years - Minnesota Duluth entered the NCC as one of the dominate volleyball powers of the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference and will return to the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference next year as one of the dominate powers of the North Central Conference. During their four-year stay in the NCC, the Bulldogs have racked up an impressive 45-3 (.938) NCC record while posting a 112-15 (.882) mark overall. UMD never lost a home NCC match, losing only on the road (twice to UNO and once to USD). The Bulldogs lost on Oct. 22 (vs. UNO) and 23 (vs. USD), 2004 and October 21, 2005 (vs. UNO), so their only NCC losses occurred on the third weekend of October and they finished with a 28-game NCC winning streak. Individual success has also followed the Bulldogs, Vicky Braegelmann became the first player to be named NCC Player of the Year three times and coach Jim Boos is a two-time Coach of the Year honoree. In all, UMD has had 16 All-NCC players.

The Notebook

AUGUSTANA - Augustana ended the regular season and its competition in the North Central Conference with a pair of solid wins last week over North Dakota (3-1) and St. Cloud State (3-1). Against North Dakota, the Vikings had 4 match points in the third game, but UND rallied to capture the game. The Vikings responded with 21 kills and only 4 errors in Game 4 to close out the match...Augustana hit .256 for the weekend. Leading the way was Cayla Schroeder, who hit .381 in the 2 matches. Schroeder averaged 5.38 kills, tallying 43 kills and only 6 errors on 97 attack attempts. After hitting 24 kills against North Dakota, Schroeder pounded 19 kills and had .486 attack percentage against St. Cloud State...Lisa Hoegh did a little bit of everything last weekend. Hoegh averaged 16.5 assists and 3.50 digs, but also contributed with 5 kills and 5 service aces...Augustana, at 19-10, advances to the NCAA Championships for the third-straight year and 12th time in the last 13 years.

MINNESOTA DULUTH - With Saturday's win over South Dakota, Minnesota Duluth finished 12-0 in the conference for the second consecutive year. The Bulldogs also finished a perfect 12-0 at Romano Gym this season and have never lost a home NCC contest during their four years of league membership. As it was the last regular-season home match for UMD, seniors Vicky Braegelmann, Danielle Beckstrand, Crystal Hoffrogge and Kari Wolford were honored in a post-match ceremony.

MINNESOTA STATE - Minnesota State finished their regular season with a 3-0 sweep of conference rival North Dakota by the scores of 30-16, 30-14 and 30-13. The win brought the Mavericks overall record to 19-8 with a 7-5 North Central Conference record. Junior Outside hitter Ashley Nahreiner led the team in kills with 17 while senior outside hitter Dana Ostertag led the team in digs with 12. Senior setter Stef Sandstrom led the team in assists with 42 while junior middle hitter Danielle Zimmermann tied for the team in total blocks with three along with senior middle hitter Megan Stroud.
