Player of the Week Danye Guinn North Dakota

Danye Guinn of North Dakota has been named the NCC Player of the Week.

Guinn, a sophomore guard from St. Francis, Minn., averaged 15.0 points, 5.0 rebounds and 3.5 assists per game in wins over Metro State and Montana State-Billings that captured the Holiday Inn/Chinook Wireless Yellowjacket Classic. She was named the Most Valuable Player in the tournament.

She shot .588 (10x17) from the field including 7 of 10 from behind the three-point arc.

The Notebook

Augustana - Augustana went 3-0 last week to extend its winning streak to 4 games and improve to 4-2 on the season after dropping their first 2 games of the season...The Vikings scored at least 90 points in 3 of those wins after averaging just 60 points in their first 2 games...Augustana had only 7 players score against Bemidji State, but all 7 reached double figures... Amy Puthoff had the best week of her collegiate career. She matched her career-high with 17 points against Concordia-St. Paul. Then she scored 15 points, including 13 in the first half, against Bemidji State. She ended the week by scoring a career-high 23 points against Minnesota-Crookston... Augustana took home several awards at the Minnesota State Pepsi Tip Off Classic. Amy Puthoff was the leading scorer (38 points) and earned the Best Hustle Award, Ashley Holiday was the leading rebounder (21) and Alison Adamson and Chelsea DeVille were the assist leaders (9 apiece)...Augustana set a school record by attempting 46 3-pointers against Minnesota-Crookston. The previous record was 40, set against Northern State in the 1997-98 season...Ashley Holiday has 16 blocked shots already this season, bringing her career total to 152. She is now second all-time in school history. She needs 10 blocks to break the career record of 161, set by Jenn Ibis from 1991-95.

Minnesota Duluth - UMD's first three games were decided in the last 20 seconds of play ...Katy Freeman was named the Wildwood Lodge Tip-Off Classic MVP, with Katie Winkelman joining her on the All-Classic Team.
